Task

Let's give the students a text related to the topic currently being studied. Ask them to read and understand the text and design a **Lego box** related to it. Share their work on a collaborative platform, project it, and discuss the results.

The prompt can be

A LEGO box featuring a lively beach party scene. The setting includes a sandy beach with a group of LEGO figures dancing and having fun around a colorful DJ booth. Additional alternative task

Cut the text into paragraphs for the students. Each student should receive a different paragraph. Once the LEGO boxes representing the paragraphs are

completed, ask them to pair up and figure out what the original text was about. You can also adapt the task by differentiating between the students based on their language proficiency. Give a text with simpler vocabulary to the less experienced language learner and a more difficult one to the more advanced speaker. The important thing is that the content of the text remains the same. Compare the completed LEGO boxes.

An optional text could be:

(It's even harder if it is a dialogue, or contains a dialogue.)

Emma:

This place is perfect, isn't it?

Jack:

Yeah, I love how quiet and relaxing it is. The sun, the sea... and that little café over there—it looks like the ideal spot for a snack.

Emma:

Totally! How about we grab some ice cream after this? They have a great selection at the "Beach Chairs" café.

Jack:

Sounds good to me! But first, I'm thinking about taking the boat out for a quick ride. You up for it?

Emma:

Oh, definitely! Let's go. After that, we can just relax by the water and soak in the sunset.

Jack:

Deal! A perfect beach day!
